

MUSIC SCENE RENTAL INSTRUMENT AGREEMENT (Effective 7/1/2024)

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. All rental payments will apply toward the purchase of the instrument. If the instrument is returned prior to the completion of the rental term, no refund will be given, as all money received shall be considered rental payment until full payment is made.
2. Only credit/debit cards will be accepted as method of monthly rental payment. Cards will be charged on the 15th of each month. Customer is responsible for informing Music Scene know of any changes to their card.
3. Music Scene LLC retains full title and ownership of the instrument until full payment has been made, and renter agrees not to sell, mortgage, remove from state or country, or otherwise dispose of the instrument until such full payment has been made.
4. If rental payment is declined for any reason, a **\$20.00 processing fee, plus tax** will be applied when the installment payment is made.
5. At any time during the rental period, the customer can return the instrument. A returned instrument must be in good condition with normal wear allowed. Instruments returned with excessive damage will result in additional costs being assessed, determined by the Music Scene Repair Shop.
6. At any time during the first 24 months of the rental agreement, the customer may purchase the instrument at 25% off their remaining rental balance.
7. After signing the rental agreement, customer can elect to purchase the instrument at the original purchase price for 120 days (interest free).
8. Should the customer default on 2 consecutive monthly payments, Music Scene will notify the customer and student's band director that the account is in arrears and the instrument may be repossessed. Full payment for delinquent payments and late fees will be required before the instrument can be returned to the customer.
- 9. Customer agrees to give Music Scene permission to contact the school's band director and/or administrative staff if rental payments are in arrears and repossession is necessary.**

Optional REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PLAN

1. During the rental period, an instrument is covered under the Repair and Maintenance Plan as described below as long as rental payments are current.
2. In the event the instrument is damaged or deteriorates in performance for reasons other than misuse, Music Scene LLC will repair and/or adjust the instrument at no charge while under the rental contract.
3. All covered repairs must be made by staff at Music Scene LLC. Any unauthorized repairs may void the coverage.
4. Coverage includes accidental damage which affects the playability of the instrument. It does not include cosmetic damage or replacement of consumable items. Consumable items include: drum heads, drum sticks/mallets, strings, bows, reeds, pads, corks, lubricants, case hinges, case zippers, straps and mouthpieces.
5. The Repair and Maintenance Plan also covers an annual inspection, generally recommended during the summer months.
6. Theft of instrument is not included in the REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PLAN
7. Music Scene must be notified immediately of any damage to claim coverage.
